## Scholarship Application Information

### ***Introduction***

The Ramona Junior Fair and its supporters would like to assist students in their academic and personal advancement. We will be awarding several \$500.00 scholarships to qualified 4-H, FFA and Grange students. Each applicant shall have plans to further their education by attending a 2 or 4-year college or vocational school at any institution of higher learning. Students should have exhibited in the Ramona Junior Fair for at least 2 years and actively contributed to the success of the Fair.

Qualified applicants are those students who are

- Graduating seniors
- Members in good standing in 4-H, FFA or Grange
- Eligible to participate in the Ramona Junior Fair

### ***Application Requirements***

To be considered for these scholarships, applicants must submit the following:

#### **1. APPLICATION FORM**

Complete the scholarship application form

#### **2. SHORT ESSAY**

The short essay (1 page or less), must be typed and double-spaced. Please include the following information in your essay, and any other information you feel important in the consideration of your application:

#### **3. PROVIDE THREE (3) LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION**

The three (3) letters may be submitted separately or with the application packet, but must be received or postmarked by the deadline. Recommendations shall be completed on the appropriate Recommendation Form provided in this packet. The committee should receive a recommendation from the following:

- Teacher or administrator from your school
- Leader or advisor
- Ramona Junior Fair Board of Director (current or past)

#### **4. STUDENT TRANSCRIPT**

A current school transcript that includes a college GPA (Grades 10-12)
